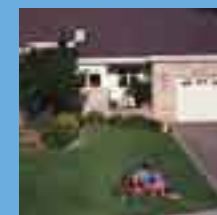

Estate Donation - 4-room apartment/house, full contents, GIC will pack and have appraised.

Senior Downsizing - 4-room apartment/house, contents include pictures, wares, etc. Items must be packed by owners.

GIVE TO GOODWILL: A NAME OF HONESTY AND TRUST. Not all organizations that collect donations make the best use of them. Some thrift stores solicit donations under the name of charity but as little as 5 percent of the money generated from these donations may actually go to the charity. At Goodwill, 84 percent of our revenues are funneled directly back into our employment and training programs. Goodwill is consistently ranked among the top charities that make your donation go further.
